**Materials and Methods.** Add here a short description of the materials and methods used during your research.

**Results and Discussion.** Add here a short description of results and discussion regarding your research. **No figures, tables and graphics.**

**Conclusions.** Add here a few important conclusions.

**Keywords.** Add here 3-5 keywords.

**Acknowledgements.** This is optional. You can add here the programme that funded your research.

**Page Setup.** The page layout is A4 format page; Margins: Top 2 cm, Bottom 6.5 cm, Inside 2 cm, Outside 2 cm; Orientation: Portrait, Mirror margins, Sections start: New Page, Header 0 cm, Footer 7.5 cm. We recommend you that you use this template and copy-paste tool. Do not number the abstract's page nor use any footnotes, nor endnotes.
